

MAIL ART AND HUMAN RIGHTS CALL

The Embassy of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic in Mexico invites you to participate in: *What if I were Sultana Sidi Brahim Haya?*

In 2022, for the commemoration of *International Women's Day*, the Embassy of the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic in Mexico held a collective exhibition of *Mail Art and Human Rights*, with the aim of denouncing and disseminating the siege suffered by the Saharawi activist *Sultana Sidi Brahim Haya*, known as *Sultana Haya*, in the occupied Western Saharan territory. Due to the participation of artists around the world and the concern of being part of this exhibition, **we extend the call.** To continue adding voices and views that seek peace dialogues for Sultana Haya, for the Saharawi people and for the world.

If you want to be part of the exhibition *What if I were Sultana Sidi Brahim Haya*? Check the rules, sign up and participate!

Rules:

1.- Artists around the world who wish to create a postcard in honor of the Saharawi activist Sultana Haya can participate.

Main themes: Human Rights, territory of the Sahara Occupied by Morocco, Saharawi women, cease the violation of human rights in Western Sahara, complaints of violation of the human rights of Saharawi women.

2.- Mail Art: the artwork must be on cardboard, coated paper, watercolor paper, or the material that the artists consider ideal to expose without a frame. Measures: 10.5 x 15 cm, 10 x 15 cm, or 14 x 9 cm.

3.- Free technique: watercolor, oil, pencil, charcoal, markers, ink, digital art, collage, calligraphy, etc. ¡Imagination is the only limit!

4.- The artwork/postcard must be sent to the physical address of the SADR Embassy in Mexico, Descartes 91, Anzures, Miguel Hidalgo, 11590, Mexico City, CDMX. Addressed to the Embassy of the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic in Mexico. If there is a shipping cost, it will be the responsibility of the participants.

4.1.- Along with the artwork, a technical file must be included with the following information: name, nationality, title of the piece, technique, email, telephone number and social media.

5.- The call will be open from its publication until Tuesday, November 29, 2022, at 00:00 hrs. Mexico City time. *Check the shipping times from your country so that your piece arrives on time.*

6.- The artists yield to the organizers, the use of the artwork for its physical and/or virtual exhibition for an indefinite period. They also accept the total or partial reproduction of the work for dissemination purposes. At all times the artists will have the authorship of the work and will be given credit.

7.- The artists selected for the exhibition of the work will receive recognition for their participation.
